With the second largest oceanic capacities in the world (11 million square km), over four maritime fronts (English Channel, North Sea, Atlantic Ocean and Mediterranean sea), France gets a substantial asset concerning Renewable Marine Energies.

In 2020, the current projects will generate the ongoing installation of 50% on a total of 6GW in Normandy, Brittany and Loire River regions.

On a long run France will combine four different technologies; offshore wind, tidal flow, wave energy converter and floating turbines.

France will count on the extensive energy's experiences of worldwide known major groups to carry out those projects (EDF, GDF-SUEZ, AREVA, ALSTOM) combined with approved subcontractors.
